



Palos Verdes Marathon GENERAL INFORMATION



Special Instructions:

Your event callsign, reporting location, and net operating frequencies will be provided to you separately via email.

Aid Stations:

If you are assigned to an Aid Station, upon your arrival contact Net Control and advise that you are “on location.” Then make contact with the lead representative of the aid station volunteers and identify yourself.

AID STATION 1: Located in front of #1467 West Paseo Del Mar, on the ocean side of West Paseo Del Mar between South Weymouth Avenue and Jackstadt Street in the city of San Pedro.

Show-Up time is 6:30 AM, first runners can be expected by 7:05 AM.

AID STATION 2: Located on South Western Avenue, on the west side of South Western Avenue and just south of West 25th Street in San Pedro.

Show-Up time is 6:40 AM, first runners can be expected by 7:11 AM.

AID STATION 3: Located in the entry drive (Catalina Vis) of 2275 West 25th Street, on the ocean side of West 25th Street in San Pedro.

Show-Up time is 6:45 AM, first runners can be expected by 7:17 AM.

AID STATION 4: Located on the ocean side of Palos Verdes Drive South at the intersection of Forrestal Drive (North) and Ocean Trails Drive (South) in Rancho Palos Verdes.

Show-Up time is 6:55 AM, first runners can be expected by 7:23 AM.

AID STATION 5: Located on the ocean side of Palos Verdes Drive South at the intersection of Peppertree Drive in Rancho Palos Verdes.

Show-Up time is 7:05 AM, first runners can be expected by 7:34 AM.

AID STATION 6: Located on the ocean side of Palos Verdes Drive South at the intersection of Berkentine Road, in Rancho Palos Verdes.

Show-Up time is 7:15 AM, first runners can be expected by 7:39 AM.

AID STATION 7: Located on the ocean side of Palos Verdes Drive South, just across from the “Admiral Risty” restaurant, in Rancho Palos Verdes.

Show-Up time is 7:20 AM, first runners can be expected by 7:51 AM.

AID STATION 8: Located on the ocean side of Palos Verdes Drive West at 2905 Via Anacapa, in Palos Verdes Estates.

Show-Up time is 7:30 AM, first runners can be expected by 7:59 AM.

AID STATION 9: Located in front of 2200 Paseo Del Mar, near the intersection of Yarmouth Road, in Palos Verdes Estates.

Show-Up time is 7:40 AM, first runners can be expected by 8:08 AM.

Rovers / Support Vans / EMS Vehicles:

ROVER 1: Meet Net Control operator at Start / Finish area. Area of responsibility is from the Start / Finish area to Aid Station 4. Show-Up time is 6:00 AM.

ROVER 2: Meet Net Control operator at Start / Finish area. Area of responsibility is from west of the slide area of Palos Verdes Drive South into Palos Verdes Estates. Show-Up time is 6:00 AM.

VAN 1: YMCA support van. Meet at Point Fermin Park at 6:00 AM; then standby at Aid Station 4.

VAN 2: YMCA support van. Meet at Point Fermin Park at 6:00 AM; then standby at Admiral Risty restaurant parking lot across from Aid Station 7.

EMS 1: Emergency Medical Service support vehicle. Meet at Point Fermin Park at 6:00 AM and standby the Start / Finish area.

EMS 2: Emergency Medical Service support vehicle. Area of responsibility is the Marathon course as directed.

EMS 3: Emergency Medical Service support vehicle. Area of responsibility is the Marathon course as directed.

Miscellaneous Support Activities:

FINISH 1: Start / Finish area, Point Fermin Park. Show-Up time is 6:15 AM.

WALT 1: Event Director Walt Walston “shadow.” Point Fermin Park. Show-Up time is 6:00 AM.

PVE COMMAND: Palos Verdes Estates Command Post, located at the Palos Verdes High School, 600 Cloyden Road in Palos Verdes Estates. Activation time is 7:30 AM.

Runners Information:

The FULL MARATHON should commence at 7:00 AM. Full Marathon runners will be wearing bibbs displaying numbers 001 through 499. The marathon turn-around point is located at 1500 Paseo Del Mar, in Palos Verdes Estates.

The HALF MARATHON should commence at 7:30 AM with runners wearing bibbs displaying the numbers 1500 – 4000. The half marathon turn-around point is in front of the Wayfarers Chapel on Palos Verdes Drive South, in Rancho Palos Verdes.

The 5K RUN should commence at 8:00 AM with runners wearing bibbs displaying the numbers 500 – 1499. The 5K runners should only affect Aid Station 1.

Runner Tracking:

For both the Full Marathon as well as the Half Marathon, please track by bibb number the first three male and the first three female runners both out-bound as well as in-bound and report their status to Net Control.

Also track the three last place Marathon runners to aid Net Control in coordinating the closure of the respective Aid Stations.

Communications Notes:

Most locations will work fine with an HT at 4 watts; many will work with just 1 watt out. Aid Station 2 will require more than just a “rubber duck” antenna and / or higher power. Aid Stations 5, 6 and 9 as well as Rover-2 may also require more power or an antenna other than a “rubber duck.”

The L.A. County Fire Department Paramedics can be monitored on 470.5625 MHz, if you care to monitor for any problems along the course.
